

The upgradation of schools as stated above have been approved under the following terms and conditions :—

1. The Community shall provide land for extension of infrastructure facilities e.g. classrooms, teacher quarters, hostels, laboratories etc. free of cost.
2. The boundary of school campus should be well demarcated to avoid future disputes/encroachment etc.
3. The additional infrastructural requirements like additional classrooms etc. should be managed locally for the next three years.
4. Cost of development of school campus like approach road, water supply and electrification should be provided by the P and D department and placed at the disposal of PWD/Power department.
5. The department of Education will provide teachers and equipments according to laid down norms. The maintenance expenditure shall also be borne by the department of Education.
6. The department shall operationalise the scheme after getting feasibility report from the DDPI/DC concerned.
7. The department will provide laboratories facilities, library, activity room, workshop etc. of semi-permanent nature in phased manner.
